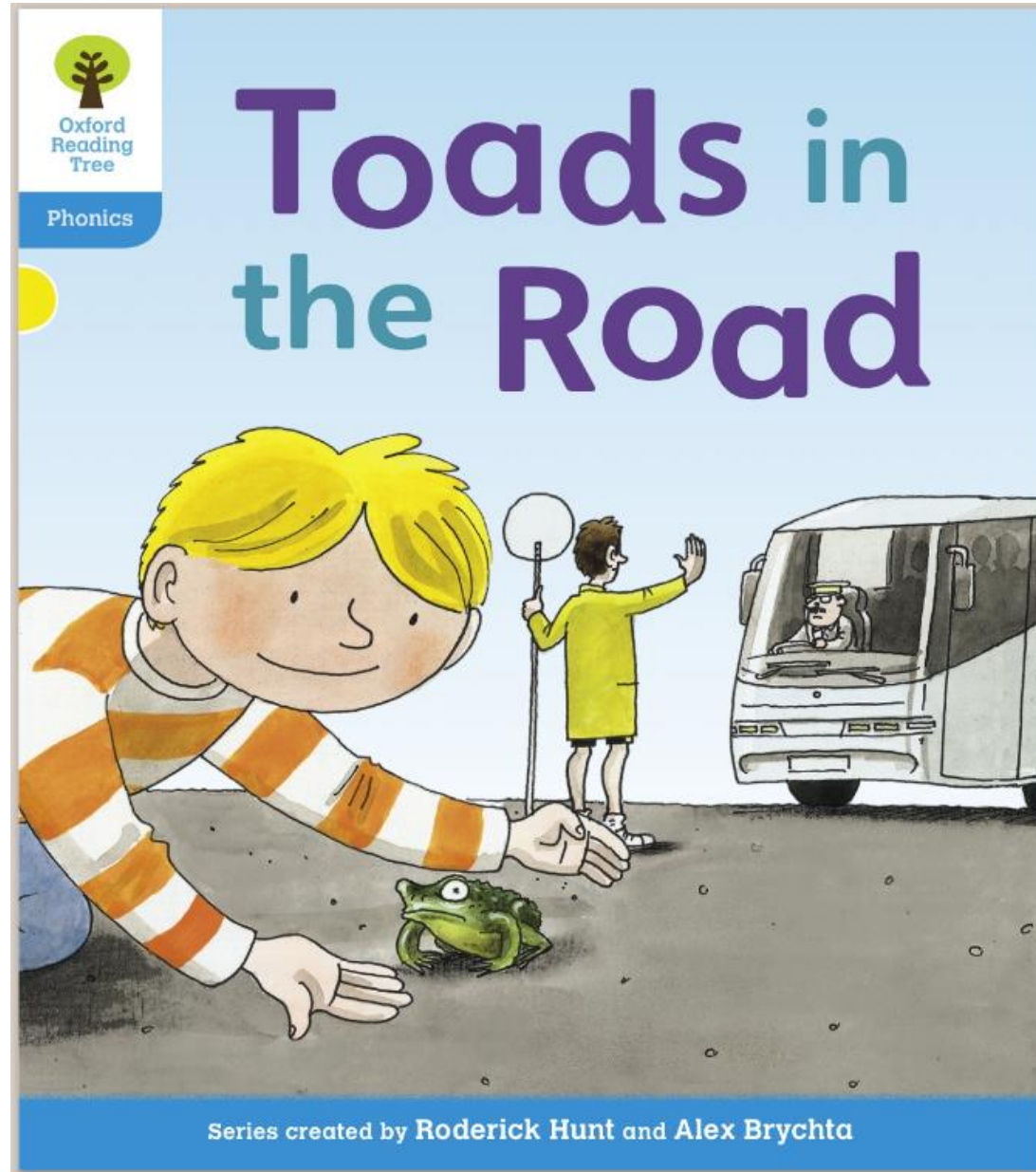

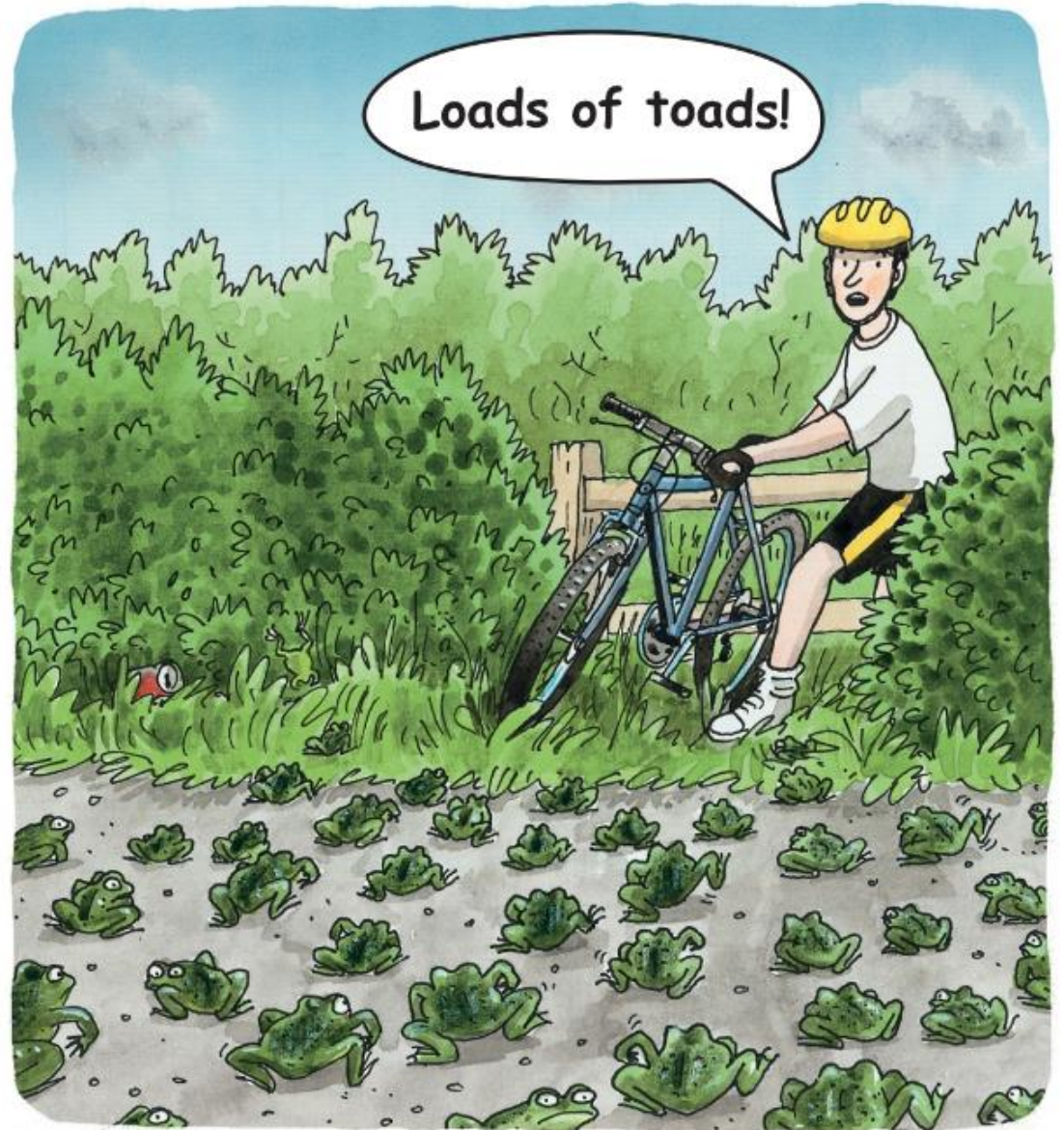
A toad was on the road.



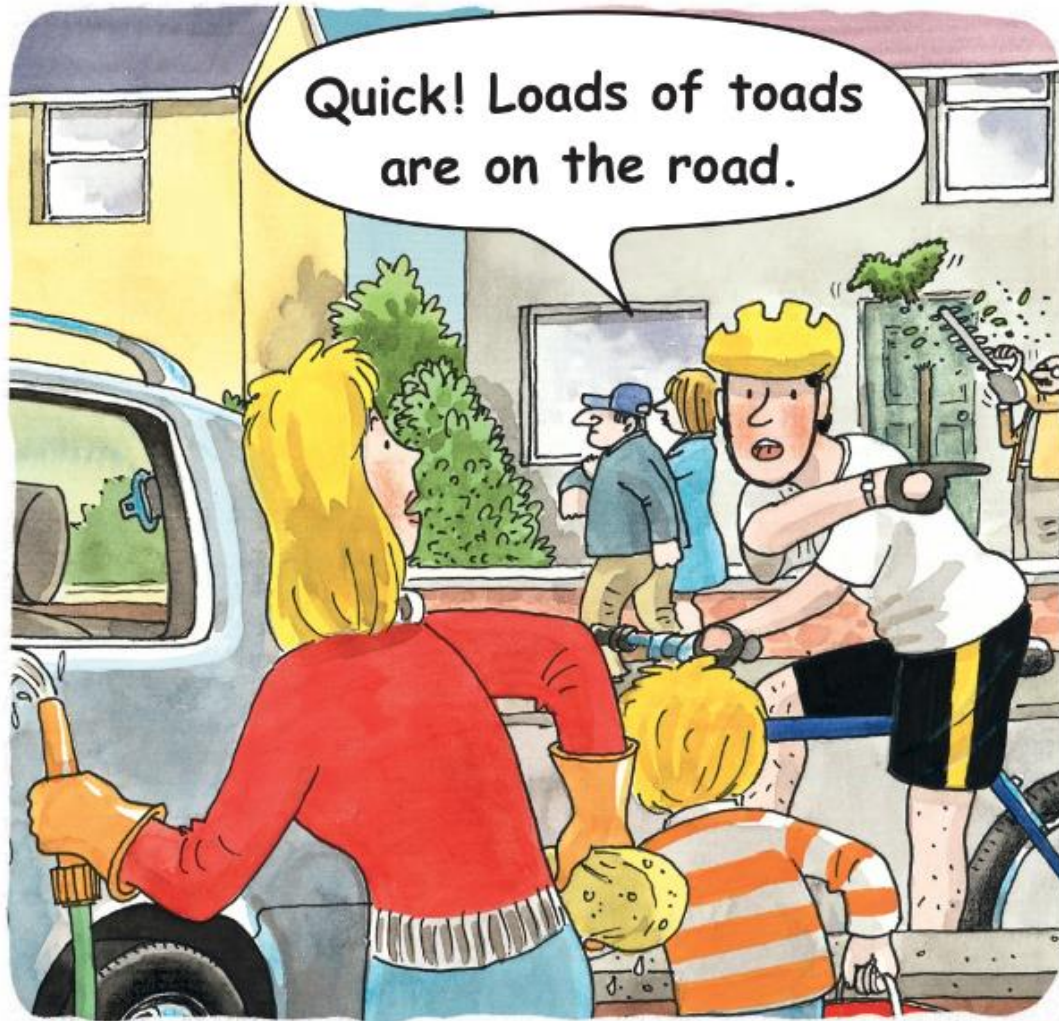
Dad put the toad down.



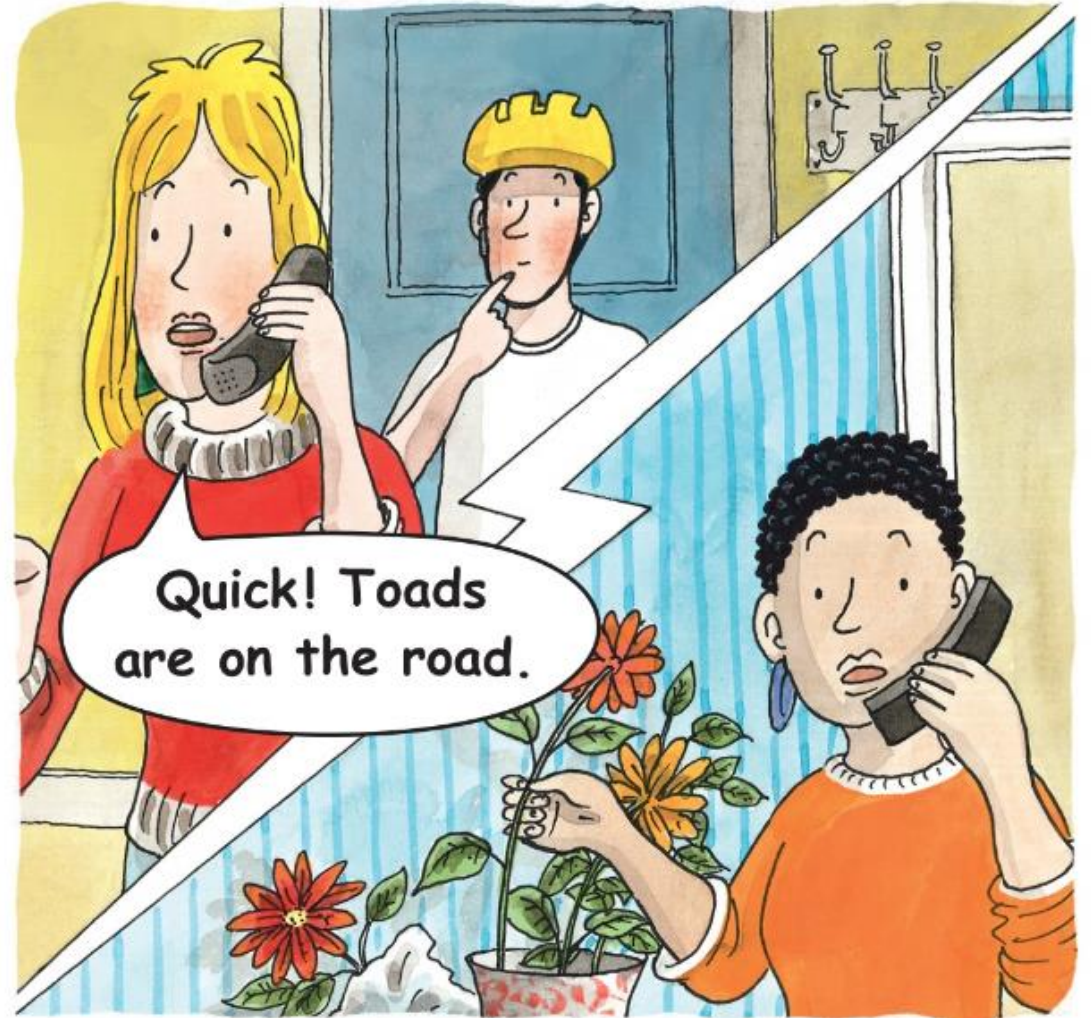
Loads of toads!



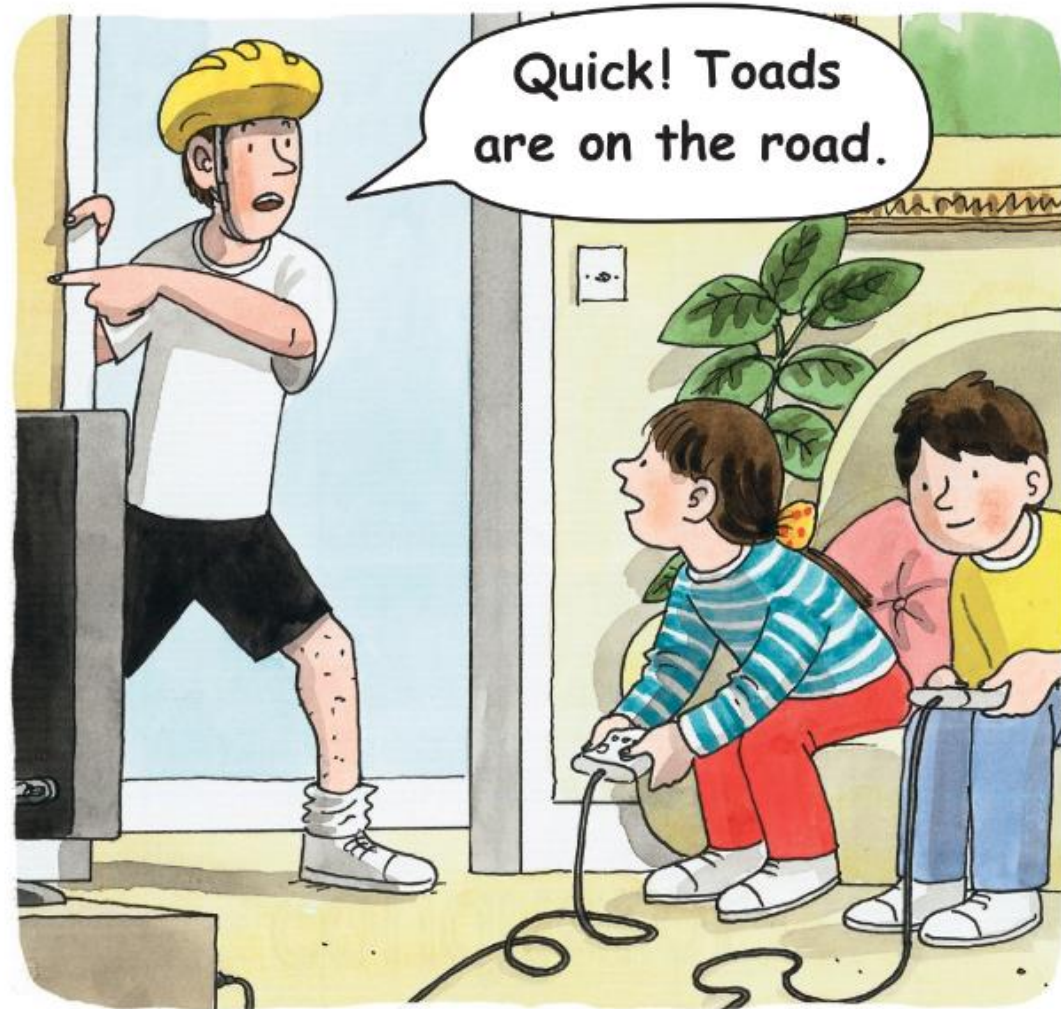
Dad ran to get Mum.

Dad got Biff and Chip.



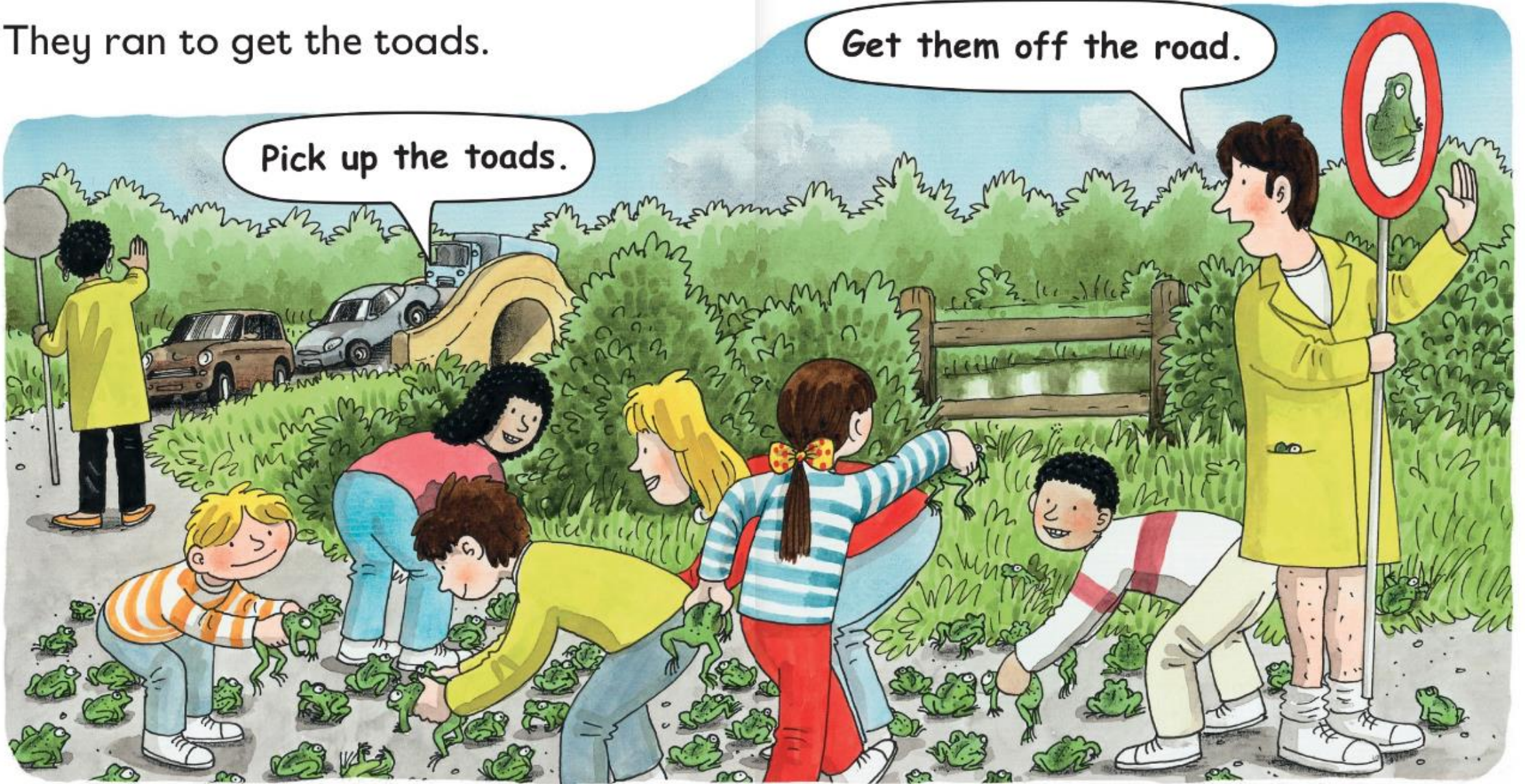
Wilma's mum had a big coat for Dad.
